<u>Creator of Material Biography</u>: The Loretto Volunteers program was originally founded as the "Loretto Southwest Volunteers" in 1989. Directed by Sr. Patricia Jean Manion, SL, volunteers worked for a summer with Sisters of Loretto in cities in Colorado and New Mexico. In 1992, the program was renamed "Loretto Volunteers" and expanded to cities outside the Southwest. Therese Stawowy, CoL became the director, a quarter-time position. In 1998, Loretto Volunteers became a member of the Catholic Volunteer Network. That same year, Sr. Sandy Ardoyno, SL became the coordinator of the program and it became a more full-time position. In 2001, Barbara Mecker, CoL was appointed as the full-time coordinator. Katie Jones served as Volunteer Coordinator from 2010 to 2014, who was then followed by Justina Shaw in 2014. Molly Butler served in the same position from 2015 to 2016. From 2017 through early 2020, Mallory Daily served as the Program Coordinator and Sr. Claudia Calzetta, SL as the St Louis Coordinator. In the spring of 2020, Annie Rosenkrantz assumed the position of Coordinator.

According to their Mission Statement in 2017, the Loretto Volunteer Program paired volunteers with social justice organizations for a formative year of service. Through meaningful work and communal living, volunteers live out the Loretto Community's mission to work for justice and act for peace - guided by the core values of social justice, community, simplicity and spirituality. The Loretto Volunteer Program ended in 2022 and was replaced by the Loretto Justice Fellows program.

<u>Description</u>: Textual material including reports, clippings, work site files, and written works of individual volunteers of the Loretto Volunteers Program mostly from the late 1990s through the 2000s. The reports include the annual reports from 1996 to 2008. These files from St Louis appeared to belong to former coordinator Barbara Mecker CoL, and as such do not include the most recent information about the Loretto Volunteers.

<u>Description</u>: Files on volunteer groups who worked at the Motherhouse in Nerinx, KY during volunteer trips. Materials are arranged by trip.

<u>Creator of Material Biography</u>: In the 2000s volunteers were often loosely affiliated with the official Loretto Volunteer Program. They were recruited by Loretto schools or Loretto persons and did not go through the application process for the year-long volunteer Program; however, in the 2000s the work of some of these groups was organized by the Loretto Volunteer coordinator. These volunteers often were high school students from Loretto affiliate high schools who came for a short week of the summer or were college students recruited by Sr. Claudia Calzetta from Southern Illinois University for service trips during their spring break.
